WE HAVE WATER BABY!

In early September of 2023, the Oakley Weber Well reached its maximum drilling depth of 2,003 feet. Drilling commenced in late May with crews working onsite for 24 hours a day 7 days a week to get through layers of quartzite bedrock. We are pleased to inform you that this well is one of the largest producing wells our engineer, hydrologist, and local specialist Doug Evans have been involved with. The well produces good clear water at approximately 1,400 gallons per minute in artesian flow and approximately 2,000 gallons per minute when pump is activated. For comparison, Oakley's average water production, prior to the new well, was approximately 800-850 gallons per minute. Drilling this well is a technical feat and we are thrilled!!

Next Steps: We are currently awaiting carbon dating and other testing of the water. Concurrently, design specifics are being finalized for the related well-house, connecting pipework, and technology. Once finalized, these documents will be put out to bid for the second phase of construction. We anticipate having water in the system and tanks, forgoing any construction delays, by Summer 2024.

Moratorium on Water Connections: We know many of you are eager to know when the moratorium will be lifted. The City Council will be considering the timing of the moratorium over the next few months. Factors related to the timing of the second phase of construction will have the most influence on the timing of the moratorium. Stay tuned to the Agendas for City Council meetings for future discussions related to the well and moratorium.

New Water & Sewer Rates

New rates were passed at a Public Hearing on August 23, 2023, by the City Council and went into effect the very next billing cycle.
